Wilenchik Walk for Life is an annual walk in honor of Michael "Tony" Wilenchik who passed away in 2009 from sarcoma. Tony, a former patient here, was a devoted civic leader in Schertz, serving as both a city councilman and mayor. The walk takes place in Schertz, Texas at the Samuel Clemens High School and benefits the Mays Cancer Center Institute for Drug Development.

- Walk/check-in begins at 8:00 a.m. at Samuel Clemons High School, Schertz
- Welcome and warm-up begins at 8:30 a.m. with run/walk beginning at 9:00 a.m.
- Children 12 and under are free and do not need to register.
- Dogs welcome.

Over the last 9 years, the walk has raised over \$160,000.
