

Floyd Curl Drive from Charles Katz Drive to Hamilton Wolfe Road will be closed from 5 p.m., Friday, Feb. 22, through Sunday, March 17. The road closure will allow the construction of the pedestrian bridge that will connect UT Health San Antonio's Barshop Institute with the South Texas Research Facility.

There will be no access to the entire Greehey campus of UT Health San Antonio from Hamilton Wolfe during the closure. This includes the Medical Arts and Research Center, the Center for Oral Health Care and Research, the Greehey Children's Cancer Research Institute, the McDermott building, South Texas Research Facility, the Research Administration Building and

UT Health San Antonio MD Anderson Cancer Center.

Floyd Curl will remain open from Wurzbach Road to Charles Katz Drive.

An alternate route is to use Charles Katz Drive and Ewing Halsell Drive to and from Wurzbach Road. Patients are encouraged to use Wurzbach to Floyd Curl. Traffic to the cancer center entrance on Wurzbach Road will not be affected.


